

DRIVING PRIVILEGE REGULATIONS

Driving your car to school is a privilege. To insure that this privilege is not revoked, please read and adhere to the following rules and regulations. Be further advised that the Administration reserves the right to revoke this privilege for reasons deemed appropriate.

Criteria for issuance and/or re-issuance will include grades: any student driver who does not earn passing grades and at least twenty (20) credits per semester will lose his/her driving privilege and must reapply at the end of the marking period to be eligible for parking. Students who receive a withdrawal of credit will not be eligible for parking privileges.

Students who are either on suspension or whose overall discipline record indicates chronic behavioral problems will be placed on conduct probation. Students who are on conduct probation will not be permitted to drive to school until the end of the marking period and then must reapply to be eligible to apply for parking.

1. All student vehicles must be registered and hang the appropriate parking tag clearly on the back of the rear view mirror inside the vehicle. Only the Security Office may issue parking tags. **NO STUDENT MAY TRANSFER HIS/HER TAG TO ANOTHER STUDENT. TO DO SO REVOKES YOUR PARKING PRIVILEGE.**
2. Parking privileges will be offered to **seniors only**. There are a limited number of spaces available. The amount of spaces available can only accommodate seniors. Underclass students who park on school grounds will have their **Parking Application delayed for 30 days.**
3. Cars are not to be visited or occupied during the day, except when the student leaves school. To do so revokes your parking privilege.
4. Cars must be parked in the area designated; failure to do so revokes your parking privilege.
5. A student is responsible for his/her vehicle the entire time that the vehicle remains on school property.
6. School buses have the right of way at all times. The buses must leave school property before the students will be allowed to leave.
7. Student's vehicles are not permitted on the bus ramp. To do so revokes your parking privilege.
8. The speed limit on school property is **5 MPH**. Parking privileges will be revoked for careless driving.
9. Parking directives issued by School Security personnel and/or staff are to be followed courteously and promptly.
10. No student is authorized to transport his/her vehicle to or from Vo-Tech School. To do so will revoke your parking privilege.

11. Administration reserves the right to independently assess any situation involving extenuating circumstances.
12. Possession or use of alcohol and/or drugs will result in a revoked parking privilege.
13. You are responsible for your tag. You are not permitted to drive to school while hang tag is "lost" or "stolen". If a tag is lost or stolen, a verifiable letter from your parent (signature and contact phone number must be supplied) must be provided and verified before a replacement hang-tag will be given. This is will approved by an Assistant Principal prior to release. Please report missing tag immediately so it can be recovered.
14. Students who park on school grounds at any time, do so with the understanding of the following: "By entering this area the person in charge of any vehicle consents to the search of the entire vehicle and its contents with or without cause by school officials".
15. **ONLY ONE TAG WILL BE ISSUED PER STUDENT. IF YOU BUY A DIFFERENT CAR, YOU MUST SUBMIT A NEW APPLICATION WITH COPIES OF YOUR NEW REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE CARD. IF AN ACCIDENT IS INVOLVED, PLEASE RETURN THE TAG OR FURNISH A COPY OF THE POLICE REPORT.**
